Privacy Policy & Website Data Protection Policy

We respect your privacy and are committed to protecting the Personal Information we hold about you. This policy sets out the basis on which we will process any personal data we collect about you, how we collect it, the measures we take to keep your data secure and the uses and disclosure we make of it.

“Personal Information” means information that relates to an individual who can be identified from that information or from that and other information which is held by or is likely to be held by Us.

Company registration number 8137325. Our principal activities are that of insurance agents and brokers and we are regulated to provide products and services to Commercial and Retail (non-investment Insurance) customers.

The Way We Use Information

Your information will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or given to any other company for any reason whatsoever, without your consent, other than for the express purpose of delivering the purchased product(s) requested.

It is our policy to ensure that all relevant statutory requirements are complied with, including the eight Data Protection Principles contained in the Data Protection Act 1998 (“the Act”), and to monitor our internal procedures periodically to ensure we are compliant.

You can access and browse our website without disclosing Personal Information.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

We may disclose your Personal Information to third parties involved in providing products or services to Us, or to service providers who perform services on our behalf
